Intro to College Studies(ICS) is a free CCV class that helps you sharpen your skills and prepare for college. It meets once-a-week for 13 weeks and is offered at all CCV locations in Vermont and at other Vermont state colleges. Not only is ICS a fun way to explore life after high school, there's a great reward once you successfully complete ICS—a free class at CCV or other participating colleges (pending available funding). Here's some of what you'll do in ICS:

- participate in activities that teach communication skills
- explore how you learn best and develop study habits that work for you
- learn to set goals for college, work, and life
- explore ways to pay for college and develop skills in managing your money
- develop stress management techniques and apply them to various situations.
